Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (Food Stamps)

If You're Over 60, It's Easier Than You Think!

- **Free application assistance** for seniors through the Southeast Tennessee Area Agency on Aging and Disability (SETAAAD)
- **No trips to DHS**—60+ applicants can request a phone interview

PLUS EXTRA BENEFITS:

- **Special deductions** and higher asset limits for 60+ applicants
 - * Asset limit is \$3,500
 - * Deduct out-of-pocket **medical expenses** over \$35 monthly
 - * No maximum "**excessive shelter costs**" deduction limit
- SNAP EBT cards are **accepted at several local farmers markets**
- SNAP recipients are eligible for AT&T's Access program which offers **broadband internet service for only \$5–10 per month** and a **free Assurance Wireless Phone**
